Eligibility

Clackamas County Farm Bureau Scholarships are available to any Clackamas County high school graduate, current county resident, or prior recipient. Required high school/college GPA of 2.8. Scholarship is available to people pursuing a career in agriculture or a related field.

Award Amount

Scholarships of between \$1,000 and \$3,000 will be awarded per recipient. (\$15,000 in scholarships was awarded in 2011.)

Scholarship Application

Please include the following information in your submission. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

Information Requested

1. High school transcript.
2. College transcript (if applies).
3. Name of college attending or college(s) applying to.
4. Two letters of recommendation are required: one letter from an ag advisor or teacher and one personal recommendation from a non-relative.
5. A hand-written, one-page letter detailing reasons for pursuing a degree in agriculture or related field.
6. Resume detailing work experiences, volunteer work, leadership activities, and participation in 4-H, FFA, and other agricultural activities. Include in this resume any honors or recognition received. (Note: This document would be the same resume you would use in applying for employment.)
7. Completed and signed application form.
